

# Wirral & District Amateur Radio Club

Directions to Irby Cricket Club, Mill Hill Road, Irby.

**FROM M53 – MID WIRRAL MOTORWAY**

**Travelling North from Chester** leave the M53 Motorway at J3 the A552

At the end of the slip road **take the first exit on the left off the roundabout onto the A552** and join the main dual carriageway travelling West. You will see an ASDA store on the opposite side of the carriageway. Follow the main road through 2 close sets of traffic lights. The speed limit is 40mph so watch for the speed camera by the bus stop on the left.

Follow the road, climbing round to the left, and as you approach Arrowe Park traffic lights (used to be a roundabout) ahead of you, position yourself in the outside lane to bear right.

**At the traffic lights .. bear right on to the A551** Arrowe Park Road along the side of the Arrowe Park Hotel on your right. The road rises slightly towards traffic lights for Arrowe Park Hospital on your left. Through the lights and continue 100 yards through another set of traffic lights which are a second access to Arrowe Park Hospital. Continue for about a ¼ of a mile to the next traffic lights (a T junction to the left) **where you turn left for Greasby into Arrowe Brook Road.**

With the Park on your left and a small business estate on your right, follow the straight road gently down hill to 30mph signs where the main road forks right, but **you want to take the left fork followed by speed de-restriction signs into Arrowe Brook Lane.** This is a winding road for just over a mile terminating in a small roundabout.

At the roundabout, with the Irby Mill public house on the opposite corner, **turn left into Mill Hill Road.** After climbing for about 100 yards you will see a lay-by on your left. (which can be easy to miss in the dark).

**Turn into this lay-by** and immediately on your left is the gate entrance to the Irby Cricket Club.

**Turn in, and drive down to and pass the Club house turning right and park in the car park by the mobile phone mast.**
